



3. Do you support legislation that prohibits distributing tax money for any reason to organizations that promote or perform abortions domestically or in foreign countries?: YES

Comment - Question 3: Yes, we should be in no way using tax dollars to fund abortion. Taxpayers should not be forced to contribute to the ending of innocent life. I am against abortion and against taxpayer funding of abortion, without exception.

I was the first statewide elected official to support the Heartbeat Bill, and was a vocal proponent for almost a decade leading up to the eventual passage of the bill in 2019. As a leader on this effort for many years, I worked side by side with pro-life organizations across the state in order to combat John Kasich, RINO Republicans in the state legislature, the left wing media and pro-abortion activists to finally get the bill passed. I spent a countless amount of time in the trenches, fighting alongside numerous pro-life groups to fight for life with no exceptions.

As a State Legislator in 2008, I co-sponsored House Bill 314, the Ultrasound Viewing Option Bill. This bill allowed women to view the ultrasound pictures of their baby before going through with the abortion.
