Aborted Babies' Bodies Dumped

Mid-December, Ohio Attorney General Mike DeWine's office released results of its investigation of Ohio Planned Parenthood abortion affiliates. The investigation examined whether state Planned Parenthood abortion facilities are selling aborted babies' body parts, and whether these facilities are properly disposing of aborted babies' remains, in light of evidence found in other states.

The investigation found that, while Ohio abortion facilities are not trafficking in the sale of aborted babies' body parts, abortionists are ignoring Ohio code requiring humane disposal of these babies' bodies. Three Planned Parenthood affiliates were cited, including Cincinnati's on Auburn Ave. As a result, bills have been proposed in both Ohio House and Senate to provide clear laws regarding humane disposal of aborted babies' bodies.

Ohio Bill Removes Funding from Abortionists

January 27th, the Ohio Senate passed Am. Sub. House Bill 294, which disqualifies abortion businesses from receiving certain federal funds administered by the Ohio Department Of Health, and redirects funds to federally-qualified health centers. We applaud the hard work of the bill's sponsors, Representatives Margaret Conditt (Butler County) and Bill Patmon (Cleveland). As of this printing, the legislation returns to the Ohio House for concurrence (agreement with version just passed) on February 10th. The bill will then go to Governor John Kasich for signature, and take effect 90 days after.

Christ Hospital Stops Aborting Disabled Babies

Late January, the *Cincinnati Enquirer* reported that The Christ Hospital in Cincinnati had been performing abortions on women carrying disabled babies not expected to survive, but the hospital now has a new policy stopping this practice. According to the *Enquirer*, The Christ Hospital was the last hospital in Greater Cincinnati to allow these abortions. This new policy is to align with those at Greater Cincinnati's four other hospital systems. Doctors may now abort babies only "in situations deemed to be a threat to the life of the mother."

Cincinnati ProLife Committee Award

Cincinnati Right to Life Executive Director, Paula Westwood, was deeply honored to receive the 2016 Cincinnati ProLife Committee's award for pro-life service. The Cincinnati ProLife Committee organizes Greater Cincinnati's annual January Rosary Rally and March through the streets of downtown Cincinnati—a powerful witness for the beautiful gift of human life. CMP Video Producer Indicted

In a stunning miscarriage of justice, January 25th a Houston, Texas grand jury indicted Center for Medical Progress founder, David Daleiden and associate Sharon Merritt, and cleared Planned Parenthood of any wrongdoing.

The grand jury indicted David Daleiden, who released undercover videos this summer exposing Planned Parenthood officials trafficking in the sale of aborted baby body parts, on a felony charge of tampering with a governmental record and a misdemeanor count related to purchasing human organs. His associate, Sandra Merritt, was also indicted on a charge of tampering with a governmental record. As of this printing, grand jury documents and next steps for this case have not yet been released. The Thomas More Society is defending David (thomasmoresociety.org).

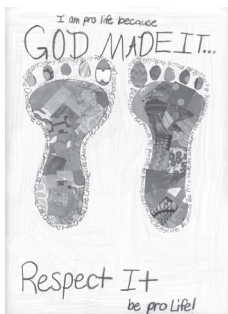
