I also focus on eliminating wasteful government spending, including fighting to stop taxpayer dollars from being paid to abortion providers, like Planned Parenthood. I'm the principal sponsor of the Balanced Budget Amendment, which would require Congress to make the tough decisions required to actually balance the federal budget.
